You would be responsible for any food and drink requirements. (This could be a potluck.) The viewing can be a large or small gathering of people. We recommend engaging guests in a conversation about why a discussion about culture is so important, especially today when there is a need to foster compassion and cultural understanding. Depending on the scheduled date, a representative of the production team could be available to help set-up a screen and projector and answer any questions concerning the overall production. (You can also use your television or computer.)

During the event, you do not have to do any heavy lifting as far as fundraising is concerned. If people want to make a donation, you can direct them to a QR Code provided by us where they will complete a form and send their donation electronically. If they prefer, they can also write a check out to Village-Connect. All financial contributions are tax-deductible.

In exchange, you will receive a complimentary ticket to the official documentary screening with reserved seating in 2025.
